

SCVAL track roundup

Soph runs 4:22.4 mile

Wilcox miler Mike Ryan turned in the best individual performance of Thursday's Santa Clara Valley Athletic League track and field meets. But his team took an awful drubbing from Los Altos and Del Mar in a triangular affair.

Ryan, only a sophomore, ran a 4:22.4 mile as Los Altos was win-

ning the meet with 94 points to Del Mar's 41 and Wilcox's 16.

Other outstanding performances were Steve Coy's 22-9/4 broad jump and Bob Feero's 15.1 high hurdles mark, both for Los Altos. Coy also won the 220 in 23.9

In other SCVAL track activity, Awalt beat Mountain View 79 1/2-

42 1/2, Fremont defeated Cupertino 72-50, and Sunnyvale nipped Homestead 64-58. Buchser and Santa Clara meet under the lights tonight at Santa Clara.

Max Lowe regained some of his championship high-jump form as Awalt beat Mountain View. Lowe cleared 6-3 1/2.

Dennis Schaumburg provided the top Mountain View mark with a 42-10 triple-jump. The meet was high-lighted by close victories. Awalt's Bob Childs won the broad jump by a quarter inch at 20-3 3/4 and Mountain View's Greg Winstead took the shot-put by the narrowest of margins at 45-10.

Fremont's easy win was sparked by Bruce Wilhelm's top weight marks. Wilhelm put the shot 60-10 and flipped the discus 160-7. Cupertino's Bob Rideout pole-vaulted 13-1 1/2 and Jim Duran won both the 220 and 440.

Bob O'Brien was the only double winner in the Sunnyvale-Homestead meet, taking both the hurdles for Homestead in slow times.

Mahan, Wilhelm star for Fremont

Gary Mahan and Bruce Wilhelm led Fremont over Awalt in Thursday's only SCVAL track activity. Three other meets were rained out.

Mountain View and Buchser will not reschedule their meet. Sunnyvale at Wilcox and Cupertino at Santa Clara made up their rainouts this afternoon.

Mahan won three events and Wilhelm took two as the Indians defeated Awalt 66-56. Mahan was timed in 10.4 and 23.7 in the sprints on a slow track, and he won the broad jump with a leap of 21-4½.

Wilhelm took the weights as usual. He put the shot 61-2 and tossed the discus 166-11 in less-than-ideal conditions.

Wilhelm's marks were the best as the wet slowed things down considerably.

The Los Altos-Homestead meet also was called off. It will not be rescheduled.

Coach Leo Long of Los Altos got some bad news, in addition to the rain, when he learned that ace hurdler Bob Feero is out.

Feero, almost a cinch to win both the high and low stick titles in the SCVAL, injured his back broad jumping and will be unable to compete for the remainder of the season.

Long said:

"The loss of Feero makes a difference of 27 points. He could have won both hurdles races in the league finals, placed in the broad jump and anchored the relay team.

"Now we will have trouble. It gives Sunnyvale and Fremont a big advantage in the relay."

Los Altos competes in the Martinez relays Saturday, the last meet before the SCVAL championships.

The league meet will be held at Sunnyvale High School next Friday.

Half-milers star in SCVAL track

Two sparkling performances in the half-mile highlighted Thursday's SCVAL track activity.

Fremont trampled Homestead 107-115, Los Altos had no trouble with Awalt 95-27, and Mountain View romped over Wilcox 79-43. The Sunnyvale-Santa Clara meet was rained out and rescheduled for this afternoon, weather permitting. Buchser-Cupertino was

also rained out and they will meet Tuesday.

The outstanding half-miles were turned in by Paul Graham of Los Altos and Mike Ryan of Wilcox. Graham barely beat two teammates across the finish line in an extremely fast 1:58.4. Ryan was all alone in front of a spread-out field and won handily in 1:58.9.

The Los Altos-Awalt meet provided most of the day's top marks, despite poor track conditions. Graham beat teammate Paul Zipp in the 880, as Zipp also went under two minutes. Chuck Smart won the weights at 57-3 and 169-9 for the Knights.

As usual, Bob Feero took both hurdles in 15.4 and 20 flat. Steve Coy was a double winner in the broad jump, with an outstanding leap of 22-9¾, and the 220, in 23.9.

In the Los Altos-Awalt Class B meet, freshman Terry Pennel of Los Altos tossed the discus 143-11½ and put the 10 pound shot 54-6½.

Fremont had no trouble with Homestead, as the Mustangs won only one event. Scott Mitchell took the low hurdles in a good 21.7, the first time he ever ran the event.

Bruce Wilhelm led Fremont with a double win in the shot put and discus. He put the shot 62-8 and won the discus in 182-7. Gary Mahan won three events. He took the sprints in 10.1 and 23 flat and broad jumped 21-2¼ for another win.

Mountain View's Clyde Izuni won three events to lead the Eagles past Wilcox. His best mark was a 21-3½ broad jump, as he also won the low hurdles and the 100-yard dash.

title last year, amassed 83 points to 36 for second place Los Gatos. Close behind, tied for third place, were Sunnyvale and Campbell with 34 points.

Tournament directors selected quarter-miler Jim Duran of Cupertino as the outstanding performer of the meet. Duran's 48.9 effort in the 440 broke Ray Medina's 1962 meet record of 49.1.

Sophomore Mike Ryan of Wilcox broke last year's meet record by more than seven seconds in clocking a 4:20.8 mile. Ryan was pushed by second-place Joe Biber of Buchser all the way. Biber topped his previous best mark by 10.5 seconds with a 4:22.0 finish.

In all, 10 meet records were broken.

Steve Coy, Paul Graham and Bob Feero were the winners for Los Altos. Coy won the broad jump with a leap of 22-4½, Graham's time of 1:58.6 won the 880, and Feero took the low hurdles in 20.0.

Tom Gibbons of Campbell came within one-half inch of this year's national best in the triple jump with a mark of 45-½.

Bob Feero's two outstanding hurdle times led Los Altos to a surprisingly easy 75½-45½ win over Fremont Thursday in the highlight of SCVAL track activity.

In other meets, Cupertino nipped Awalt 62½-59½, Buchser nudged Sunnyvale 62½-58½, and Mountain View swamped Homestead 97-25.

Feero ran the high hurdles in a good 14.6, and then flew over the low hurdles at a 19.8 clip to lead the Knights. Steve Coy also was a double winner for Los Altos, taking the broad jump with a good

leap of 22-8, and winning the triple jump in a respectable 43-5. Chuck Smart took the discus with a toss of 163 feet.

Gary Mahan was the outstanding Fremont performer, winning two events and finishing close behind in a third. Mahan ran a 9.9 century, a 22.5 220, and finished close behind Coy in the broad jump with a more than respectable leap of 21-5½. Bruce Wilhelm won the shot-put at 61-8.

The Awalt loss to Cupertino may prove costly, as ace Awalt high-jumper Max Lowe had to leave his specialty at 5-7 after he pulled

a muscle. He didn't place in the event. The meet went right down to the relay, which ended in a dead heat.

Jim Duran did well for Cupertino, sweeping the sprints in times of 10.0 and 21.4. The latter is one of the top 220 times in the Bay Area so far this year. Other top performances came from Cupertino's Bob Rideout and Al Mullen. Rideout pole-vaulted 13-3, and Mullen tossed the discuss 167-9.

John Figueroa won three events for Sunnyvale, but he wasn't enough, and the Jets bowed to Buchser. Figueroa swept the

sprints in 9.8 and 21.4, and then won the broad jump, the first time he has competed in that event, with a leap of 21-6½.

Buchser's win was due mainly to a team effort, but the Bruins got a top performance from Joe Biber in the mile. He won easily in a good 4:31.8.

Mountain View had no trouble with Homestead, relying on balanced competition to carry the day. The only double winner for either team was Mountain View's Izuni, who won the 100 in 10.5, and the low hurdles in 21.5.
