Carlmont spikers win 37th straight meet; Palo Alto, Woodside turn back loop foes

The Carlmont High School track team racked up its 37th consecutive victory by turning back Cubberley 67-55 in Friday's feature South Peninsula Athletic League meet held on the Cubberley oval.

In the other league meets, Palo Alto topped Sequoia 69-53, Woodside tripped Ravenswood 73-49, and San Carlos ran past Menlo-Atherton 66-52.

At Cubberley, the Scots had to overcome tremendous efforts by Cougars Burke Mitchell with a 56-4½ heave of the shot; Bill Fisher, a double winner in the 120 high and 180 low hurdles, and the upset of Scot Jack Sandin in the 440 by Cubberley's Nat Handy and Bill Birtwhistle.

Carlmont received fine performances by Mike and Martin McCann in the two mile and mile runs, respectively. Mike was clocked in a good 9:42.1, in the two mile and his twin brother, Martin, won the mile in 4:35.4.

The top race of the day was the 440. Sandin was a strong favorite in the race, but Handy and Birtwhistle caught Sandin at the final turn, and outraced the Carlmont flash to the wire. Both Cougars had a time of 52.0 and Sandin was clocked at 52.1.

In the dashes, Cubberley's John Coffron and Carlmont's Andy Sears split the two events. Coffron won the 100, while Sears took the 220.



Paly, Cubberley in easy wins

Cubberley, Menlo - Atherton and Palo Alto romped to easy track wins in South Peninsula Athletic League meets Friday afternoon.

Cubberley defeated Sequoia 85-37 as John Coffron clicked

off a 9.9 hundred, also won the 220-yard dash, and was the anchor man for the Cougar relay team that whipped through the half mile in 1:31.0.

Burke Mitchell won the shot put with a heave of 54-7³/₄, for the best mark in the field events.

Palo Alto defeated Woodside 81-41 with Barry Mathis and Dennis Milligan providing the best marks.

Milligan, a junior was under two minutes in the half mile for the second week in a row, as he won in 1:59.5.

Mathis set a meet record in the broad jump with a leap of 21-3.

Dick Dwiggins was the big point scorer for Woodside. He won the 120-yard high hurdles and the high jump and was second to teammate Steve Crosby in the 220-yard dash.

Bert Warden led Menlo-Atherton to a 74¹/₂-47¹/₂ win over every one of the flat races — the 100, 220, 440, 880, mile and two mile. They also took firsts in the pole vault, shot put, and discus.

Warden won the 100 in 9.9 and also won the 220-yard dash.

The best B marks of the day were a 21-10¹/₂ broad jump by Dave Locke of Cubberley, and a 12-foot pole vault by Dave Laur of the Cougars.

Cubberley won the meet 79-34.

Milligan runs another 1:57

Dennis Milligan of Palo Alto, Andy Sears of Carlmont, and Burke Mitchell of Cubberley were the standouts in South Peninsula Athletic League track meets Friday.

Milligan ran the half mile in 1:57.0 for the second time this week. He is a junior and will be favored to win the SPAL title.

Sears, the Carlmont sprint star, ran the 100-yard dash in 9.8 for the second time in a row. He also will be favored in the SPAL finals which will be held May 8 at Sequoia High School.

Mitchell came up with the third best shot put in SPAL history when he tossed the 12-pound 12-pound ball 56-9. The only others to throw farther in SPAL competition were Don Castle of Cubberley and Larry Kennedy of Menlo-Atherton.

Cubberley defeated Menlo-Atherton 78-44, Palo Alto beat Ravenswood 73-49, Carlmont crushed Woodside 81-41 to complete the dual meet season unbeaten, and Sequoia topped San Carlos 74-48.



In the C division, Sequoia and Ravenswood pulled even with idle San Carlos. All three squads now have 3-0 records.


