Another era in the colorful Big Meet history ends today, as eras did in the past when Walter Christie retired and when Dink Templeton retired. Next year's Big Meet battle will be in the hands of younger men and a new era at California will begin.

Fittingly it is the Brick Muller Society that is paying its tribute to Brutus today. Brick and Brutus were brothers of the spirit and the Society in Brick's name could do itself no more justice than to honor Brutus Hamilton.
