Wins Relays

Burlingame High School reigns as the 1965 Blossom Hill Relay champions.

The Panthers, competing against 40 other Northern California high schools, tallied 36 points to annex the crown at Leigh High School Saturday.

It proved to be a Mid-Peninsula League dominated affair as Aragon, charging in with 34 points, grabbed the runnerup honors.

The Panthers' Jeff Demanes, competing in varsity silks for the first time this year, won first place in the pole vault with a best-ever vault of 13-6. Aragon's Paul Wilson took third place, clearing the bar at 13-0.

Burlingame's Randy Weil was fourth in the 120 high hurdles with a 15.3 clocking, while the varsity 880 relay team grabbed a second place with a 1:31.0. Aragon was second in the 880 relay.

In the class B activity, the Panther mile and one-half relay team took a second and the 440 relay team a fourth.

Azevedo wins highs at Blossom Hill Relays, eyes WVVAL

Ron Azevedo, Los Gatos High School junior today is eyeing the 1965 West Valley Athletic League hurdles championships after an impressive showing Saturday in the second annual Blossom Hill Relays at Leigh High School.

Azevedo, the 1964 B hurdles champ, won the 120-yard highs in 15.2, followed closely by teammate Randy Kermode, and he was third in the 180 lows, close behind a 19.8 performance by Bud Sterling of

Overfelt.

Burlingame won the team title with 36 points. Other finishers in the top 13 were: Aragon 34, Watsonville 31, Cupertino 26, Leigh 25, Overfelt 22, Homestead 22, Sunnyvale 21, Fremont 21, Bellarmine 21, Buchser 18, San Jose 18 and and Los Gatos 17.

Leigh mile and half relay team was first in 6:02.1 and Pete Fehler of Del Mar won the Pentathlon with 354 points.

Saratoga's Mike Butler was

second in the pole vault, clearing 13 feet. Leigh's impressive sophomore, Rich Dunn, recorded a mark of 45-ft. 4-in. in the triple jump (hop, step and jump).

Bellarmino's Bruce Nagle was the only double winner, taking the discus with a toss of 164-6¼ and winning the weightman's 100-yard dash in 11.0.
