Eaglet Spike Teams Give Coach Memorable Going Away Gift

Mountain View's spirited Class Cee and Dee track and field teams gave Vern Thornburg two of the finest going away presents a coach would want — two SCVAL championships.

Thornburg, who will be cross country coach next fall at the new Lynbrook High School, thinks determination on the part of every boy on both teams was the determining factor in the two titles.

"Most of these kids missed out by a point in last year's league finals" said Thornburg "and I could sense from mid-season on that they felt they could go all the way this time. "They deserve a great deal of credit for their hard work and dedication."

About the only thing Thornburg can't understand is his

escape from being thrown in the swimming pool. Tossing a coach in the pool is traditional among teams who have won league crowns. "Maybe they didn't want to ruin the suit I had on," said Thornburg.

These two titles were the first outright crowns won by the Eagles in four years and on that occasion it also was two titles in track.

Michael Sanchez registered two league records in Class Cee events, 20-9 in the long jump and 42-9 $\frac{1}{4}$ in the triple jump. Carl Cruz won the 75 and 330 and freshman John Holden the 150.

Cruz and Holden also ran on the winning relay team which also included Dave Hori and Ed Mateo.

Bill Briones won the 50 and 100-yard dashes to pace the

Eaglet Dee squad and Robert Callejo was one of the unsung heroes in the triumph. Callejo, who set a league mark of 14.5 for the 120-yard low hurdles in the trials, placed second in the finals, was second in the triple jump and fifth in the long jump and also ran a leg on the second place relay team.

Brian Nakamoto won the discus with a toss of 113-9 $\frac{1}{2}$.

Although their teams didn't win titles, Jim Martin of Fremont and Todd Peterson of Los Altos registered outstanding marks. Martin soared 5-10 $\frac{1}{4}$ for a league standard in the high jump and Peterson obliterated the Cee pole vault mark with a leap of 12-0 $\frac{1}{2}$.
