BRUIN SPIKERS TROUNCE AZTEC

SAN DIEGO-Five meet records fell as UCLA's national collegiate champions opened the outdoor field and track season Saturday by trouncing San Diego State, 111-32, before 2,500 fans at Balboa Stadium.

San Diego's 'two aces, high hurdler Don Shy and half-miler Rick Herrmann, accounted for the only Aztec victories in the 17 events. Shy set a meet record of 14.1 in the highs and also placed second in the long jump. Herrmann won the 880 in 1:55.1.

One pleasant surprise for UCLA coach Jim Bush, in addition to the score, was the vaulting by Dick Railsback, junior college transfer from Pasadena, who was an easy winner at 16 feet. Railsback, who injured his back in the Times Indoor Games, was not even listed on the UCLA travelier UCLA traveling squad, but decided to compete at the last minute. He did not try any higher than 16-0.

In the absence of the big sprint names (Tom Jones, Hal Busby and Norm Jackson) from the 220, the Bruins' little (5-91/2, 145) sprinter from Calcutta, India, Barry Ford, cap-tured the furlong in 21.9.

Busby ran only on the 440 relay team, Jones ran a leg on the mile relay quartet, while Jackson won the 100 in 9.7 and anchored the 440 relay team.

The meet's only close race was the 880 where Herrmann out-kicked UCLA's Les Fendia. The Bruins' No. 1 man, Arnd Kruger, did not run after having had two teeth pulled.

Record Breakers

Bruin meet record breakers were Roger Johnson, 440 hurdles in 51.5; Gerald Lee, triple at 46 - 10; jump Larry Fischer, high jump at 6-81/8; and the mile relay team of Paul Hoyt, Fendia, Jones and Don Domansky in 3:14.9.

The UCLA frosh beat the San Diego frosh in a companion meet, 94-39.
