# Wins 2-Mile Run in 3-Team Meet

SAN DIEGO—Lt. Billy Mills, the Olympic Games 10,000 meter winner in 1964, won the two mile in 8:57.4 Thursday in a combined dual and triangular meet involving the San Diego Track and Field Club, Utah and San Diego State at the Aztec oval.

It was Mills' first outdoor appearance in a year.
