- THE BEARS: will be favored to get their first dual win of the season, against Washington State, but will be underdogs to the powerful San Jose State Spartans. Last Saturday against Oregon these encouraging things happened: Gary Pennington indicated he is on the way back with a 220-10½ javelin throw, after two weeks of sub 210¹ throwing; Pat Weddle nearly pulled out the 440 relay with an outstanding anchor leg(Bears ran 41.8, season's fastest), ran dead even with Joe Richards in the 100 although unplaced by officials, won the 220 in 21.7 and anchored the mile relay; Paddy Mc Crary, running with better than a 100-degree temperature, had a lifetime high burdle best, 14.4 for third, ran third in the 440 in 48.8 and won the intermediate hurdles; Ron Miller improved his season's discus best to 159-5½; Devone Smith, after missing five days of work, lowered his season's best to 1:51.0 in the 880; and Rich Elliott in his very first ever three mile clocked 14:28.6.
- WASHINGTON STATE COUGARS are hurting physically. Right now Gerry Lindgren, the Cougars great distance ace, is questionable for this meet. He is suffering from stomach trouble and a decision as to whether he will compete this weekend will not be made until late in the week. Also hurting are the Cougars outstanding jump star Barrie Johnson, 15-foot vaulter Jim Precht and sprinter Rich Lapham. WSU will bring to twwn one of the best javelin throwers in college, Carl O'Donnell, 245-22; 6-8 high jumper Keith Dalluge and a pair of tough halfmilers Rod Dahl and Gary Benson.
- THE SPARTANS are loaded in the dashes and jumps and have capable people every place else. With Tommie Smith and Bobby Griffin in the sprints, Lee Evans in the 220 and 140, Ricky Rogers in the hurdles and long jump, Ellis Williams in the long jump, 6hris Papanicolaou in the pole vault, Dwight Tucker in the high jump and triple jump, Ken Shackelford in the intermediate hurdles, distance runners Bill Langdon and Rich Klemmer and two tough relay teams, San Jose State is heavily favored to win 10th straight meet from the Bears.
- GOOD DUAIS are on tap in the long jump where Cal's Stan Royster and Jim Kennedy meet Spartans Ricky Rogers, Ellis Williams and Howard Butler and possibly WSU's Barrie Johnson; The pole vault, Papanicolaou v. Cal's Greg Miguel; the high hurdles, Rogers v. Kirtman; the intermediates, Shackelford v. McCrary; the mile, Langdon v. Bears' Price and Byers; the high jump, Tucker vs. Nutt of Cal and Dalluge of WSU; the javelin, WSU's O'Donnell v. Pennington of Cal and Arcide of San Jose State, and others will develop.
