Dick Railsback of UCLA again defeated USC's Bob Seagren in the pole vault after Seagren had missed 16-8, a height Railsback cleared on his first attempt. The Bruin athlete failed three times at 17-2.

Arnd Krueger of UCLA and West Germany, who usually runs the 880, ran the mile as if that might be his best event. He tangled with Tom Von Ruden of the 49er Track Club and beat him in 4:06.3 to Von Ruden's 4:07.1. Jerry Brady of

In this race Jay McDonald of Glendale Hoover High took the lead in the third lap and held it until a stride or so before the gun. Krueger passed McDonald as they neared the 1320 mark in 3:08.3, the prep being only a yard or less behind.

The Glendale boy was outrun on the last lap but was timed in 4:10.6, a mark only 2-10 seconds slower than Paavo Nurmi's one-time world record.

Danek's series read: 2-5-6, 202-1, 200-11, 194-11, foul, 199-9.

Parry O'Brien made his outdoor debut of the season in the shot and placed third at 59-10½ behind George Woods (61-10¼) and Dave Davis (60-9). Jim Bush was happy to see his UCLA ace, Steve Marcus, place fourth at 59-9½. A mark like that would score points in the NCAA.

John Buehler of Whittier High, like Newton a state champion, was unplaced but put the shot 50-9.

Ron Pharris of Anaheim High ran well in the sprints, bagging third in each. He ran the 100 in 9.6, same time as Larry Dunn of the Striders, then beat Dunn in the 220 with a rush of 21.4 as Jim Kemp got second behind Smith. In the 100 Pharris beat UCLA's Harold Busby who ran fourth in 9.8.

The 220 was run in three sections and places awarded on a basis of time.

Ron Copeland won the first of the two high hurdles races in 13.8.

Frank Covelli again beat his local rivals in the javelin, this time with a toss of 244-4 to 235-4 by Larry Stuart.

The Striders won the team trophy by so wide a margin no score was kept.
