SEATTLE Feb. 4 --The toughest event of the night at the Seattle Invitational indoor track meet occurred in the press box. It involved choosing the meet's outstanding performer.

A pair of state athletes, Gerry Lindgren, Washington State University sophomore, and Doris Brown, of Seattle's Falcon Track Club, made the selection exceedingly difficult.

Mrs. Brown was the winner by a close margin.

Both athletes thrilled the 10,195 fans. Lindgren and New Zealand's Bill Baillie staged a torrid two-mile duel before the WSU athlete took charge in the closing two laps to win in 8:31.6.

Mrs. Brown, a ~~24~~ 24-year-old Seattle junior high school teacher, sped through the 830 in 2:03.5, a new women's world indoor record. This eclipsed the 2:03.6 <sup>held</sup> ~~set~~ by Zsaba <sup>SZABO</sup> ~~of~~ of Hungary.

It was clear from the outset that Lindgren and Baillie had the two-mile to themselves. Baillie, in his initial outing ~~of~~ this winter indoor season tour, took charge at the outset and led the first six laps.

Lindgren, who will be a WSU junior this week, sped to the forefront on the backstretch of the seventh lap, and was never headed. The two were not separated by more than two yards until Lindgren burst ahead ~~on the 20th lap~~ <sup>of the 22</sup> with two of the 22 laps remaining.

The ~~two~~ duo sprinted the remaining distance on the 160-yard track but Gerry proved to have the greater reserve. Baillie was 25 yards back at the finish and was timed in 8:37.8.

Lindgren's effort is the third best two-mile ever run indoors. Ron Clarke of Australia holds the world mark of 8:28.8 and Jim Beatty is the American record holder in 8:30.8.

Baillie's leading split for the first quarter was 63, and he hit the half in 2:08. Thereafter, Gerry's <sup>leading</sup> quarter times were 3:13, 4:16, 5:19.5, 6:27, and 7:33. Both lost contact with the field after the ninth lap when they surged to a 30-yard lead.

It was a race in which such a pair of outstanding performances <sup>might</sup> ~~could~~ not be expected, although it was billed as the top event of the meet.

The tanned Baillie displayed he was in shape but he had made a long trip here and could have been expected to be tired. Lindgren had just completed ~~four~~ five final semester examinations the week of the meet and his training time ~~was~~ <sup>by</sup> reduced.

But the ~~diminutive~~ <sup>pain</sup> diminutive ~~youth~~ put on a show that Seattle track fans won't soon forget. It was worth the price of admission.

Lindgren said afterwards, "I was kind of surprised <sup>with</sup> ~~at~~ my time. After final-examination week I really didn't know what to expect. I always ~~man~~ want to run a good race here. ~~It~~ It's the closest thing there is to a home indoor meet for me."

Baillie added, "It was a tremendous race. Gerry sure has improved his finishing kick."

Lindgren, incidentally, has been concentrating on wind sprints in practice this winter. He has recognized that he needs a stronger finishing kick to stay with the world's top distance runners in the final ~~long~~ stretch of any ~~distance~~ race.

In addition to Lindgren's mark, <sup>six</sup> ~~five~~ other meet standards went <sup>or were equaled.</sup> by the wayside. Darrell Horn, of the Athens Athletic Club, took care of two. He bettered the long jump standard of 25'4" with a 25'8" leap. The triple jump mark of 50'-8", ~~made by~~ can also be written off, <sup>as</sup> Horn soared 51'0" feet.

Terry Thompson, <sup>back representing his home state of Oregon after a stint in</sup> ~~representing the Staters Track Club,~~ <sup>held</sup> ~~held~~ <sup>the</sup> off Wade Bell, of Oregon, ~~managed~~ to win the 1,000-yard run in 2:09.8, the same time credited to Bell. The old record was 2:11.3. The triumph was the second of the indoors season for the Oregon State junior transfer from the University of Missouri.

The first three place finishers in the 60-yard high hurdles equaled the meet record of 7.3. They were winner Earl McCullough of USC, second-place Bill Roe of Washington and third-place Bob Blum of Oregon.

Steve Pancoast of Oregon State bettered the 500 record of 58.0 by clocking 58.0 in leading from start to finish in a four-man
