Shy's best time of 13.4 is only two-tenths off the world record.

The day's top race should be the 880, with San Diego's Rick Hermann (1:48.0) contesting the Bruins' Arnd Kruger (1:48.4).

A freshman dual meet will also be held concurrently with the varsity competition. First event is at 1 p.m.
