SDS Clobbered by UCLA In Meeting of Track Champs

The University of California at Los Angeles bombed the Aztecs 111-32 Saturday in a battle of the defending college division (SDS) and university division (UCLA) track and field champions.

First places in 15 of 17 events were won by the Bruins but Az-tec mentor Dick Wells was pleased by his athletes performances.

"Anytime you score 32 points against UCLA that's not bad. I'mvery pleased with our distance men. Pete Virgadamo ran the best mile of his career," Wells said.

"We did well considering it is still early in the season," Wells continued, "Herrmann (Rick) ran a good race. His time was slow mainly because he is trying to develop a final kick. Shy (Don) contributed a fine performance.'

Herrmann, NCAA half-mile champion, won the 880 with a slow time of 1:55.5.

"It's early in the season and I don't feel I'm really in shape yet," said Herrmann. He also ran the anchor leg on the Aztec mile relay team which finished second.

Shy set a new meet record in the 120-yard high hurdles with a time of :14.1. The old mark of 14.4 was held by Bill Wells of UCLA in the 1960 meet. Shy placed second in the long jump with a leap of 22-61/2.

John Colson (9:10.7) and Greg Bagby (9:15.4) placed two and three in the two-mile run for SDS.
