#### DENNIS CARR RUNS 8:52.2 TWO MILE

Dennis Carr, already the No. 1 halfmiler and the No. 3 miler in Trojan history, ripped off an 8:52.2 two mile Saturday against California to become the No. 3 USC runner of all time in that event. Only faster Trojans are Julio Marin (8:46.8), 1963; and Max Truex (8:50.7n), 1958. Carr covered his last lap in 59.5.

This week Carr, who clocked 4:02.5 against Arizona State in Troy's first dual meet of the season, will shoot for a sub-4-minute mile against Washington's NCAA placer, Dave Roberts, who returned a 4:05.4 mile in the Huskies' 76-69 victory over Oregon last weekend.

#### SIX SEASONAL BESTS FOR TROY AGAINST BEARS

Trojans recorded six individual bests for the season in their 85-60 win over California Saturday in the Coliseum.

Most impressive was hurdler Earl McCullouch, who improved his all-time long jump best by 14 inches when he leaped 24-7 for third place against the Bears. Steve Craig's 23-1½ in the same event also was a seasonal high.

Other seasonal bests were Steve Johnson's 55-6 in the shot put and 160-0 in the discus, John Link's 4:06.4 in the mile and Dave Kendall's 6-6 in the high jump.
