

Knights win track meet

Brad Lyman of Los Altos, Jon Enscoe of Palo Alto and Phil Quinet of Homestead were the individual stars in a record-shattering Andrew Hill Invitational track and field meet at Foothill College Saturday.

Lyman won the 100 and 220-yard dashes and was the anchor man on the Los Altos relay team that zipped to a record 1:29.5 clocking.

The Knights easily won the team scoring title with 94 points. Homestead was second with 57.

Enscoe cracked a record in the 880-yard run as he turned in a 1:56.7 clocking — very fast for so early in the season.

Quinet won the triple jump with a leap of 46-7½ and also was second to teammate Grady Rogers with a 23-0¼ effort in

the broad jump. Rogers won at 23-1½.

Lyman was the most valuable track man and Quinet top field man in the meet.

Midpeninsula entrants won a major share of the first places. Other winners were Bob Evers of Cubberley in the low hurdles, Steve Davis of Los Altos in the discus, Ben Welsh of Woodside in the shot put, Steve Peterson of Cupertino in the pole vault, Tom Huntsberger of Palo Alto in the mile, Jeff Ruble of Los Altos in the two-mile, and the Los Altos eight-man mile relay team.

Sunnyvale won the title in a limited Class B competition.
