

CSD Wins BCAL Track Championship

ATHERTON — Bob Pedersen and William Foster each won four first place medals to do the bulk of the scoring in California School for the Deaf's easy victory in the Bay Counties Athletic League track and field championships held here Saturday.

Second place Menlo, 52½ points behind the East Bayers, got first place efforts from Art Nathan (pole vault), Brent Blaisdell (discuss) and Dave Offen (mile).

Pedersen won the 440, 220, long jump and was a relay team member. Foster won the 120 high hurdles, 180 low hurdles, high jump and anchored the winning relay team.
