

# Pad Cinders Seek Title

Serra High School's track team goes after the Catholic Athletic League championship this week at Cal State Hayward, after qualifying 19 athletes and a relay team in West Bay competition held Saturday at St. Francis High School.

Paul Guillory of St. Mary's didn't let the humidity effect him either as the Panther ace ripped off times of 9.9 in the 100 and 22.1 in the 220.

Larry Elrod brought two gold medals back to Bellarmine with him as he won the 120 high hurdles and the 180 low's. His time of 15.1 (high's) and 20.1 (low's) were above his best for the year.

The warm climate seemed to get to the distance runners more than anybody. In the two-mile, the battle between St. Mary's Tim Swensen and St. Francis' Bernie Lahde ended before the meet when Swensen had to scratch because of an illness. Lahde went on to win the event easily in 9:51.1.

In the mile, Kent Rezowalli of St. Francis stayed in the middle of the pack until the gun lap then broke away from favored Jim Tracy of Riordan to win the four-lapper in 4:35.5.

# Lou Nava Lone Serra Qualifier

**NEWARK** — Redwood City's Lou Nava was the only qualifier from Serra High School in the North Coast Section Region I track trials held here Wednesday.

# Bernie Lahde Qualifies <sup>5-29</sup> In Two-Mile

**PITTSBURG** — St. Francis' Bernie Lahde became the Lancers first ever entry in the State Meet when he qualified for the two-mile in the North Coast Section Track and Field Championships staged here Saturday.

Lahde ran the eight-lap event in 9:26.7, almost two seconds better than his previous lifetime mark. Lahde upset Rick Swenson of St. Mary's (9:20.0) and Tom Plumb (9:23.3) to earn a trip to San Diego for next weekend's State Meet.

Dave Masters of El Cerrito fought-off a tough win and a harder runner named Mel Gray of Montgomery High of Santa Rosa to win the 220 and 100-yd. dashes.

Gray won the NCS qualifying meet by tying the National schoolboy record of 9.4 in the century last weekend in Santa Rosa.
