Carlmont Poor Host— Wins Own Relays

SAN MATEO — Carlmont High's track team won seven of thirteen first places, scoring heavily in the field and distance relays, and walked away with the Carlmont District Relays held at the College of San Mateo, Saturday. The Scots scored 76½ points to second place M-A's 42½.

The meet was originally scheduled for last Saturday at Carlmont with the top teams in Northern California entered, but the rainy weather forced cancellation and coach Loren Lansberry invited the Sequoia District teams to compete for the medals supplied by the Belmont Rotary and the Carlmont Athletic Department.

SPAL teams will be back at the oval Tuesday with a full schedule of duals meets. Palo Alto is at San Carlos; Sequoia will travel to Menlo-Atherton; Woodside will journey to Gunn and Cubberley will test Carlmont. All meets begin at 3:15.

One of the top races Saturday was the four-mile relay. Carlmont's Bruce Eaton and Sequoia's Rich Terriberry ran stride-for-stride for 3½ laps before Eaton pulled away within the last 220 for a 20 yard margin of victory.

Another top race was the 440 relay. Menlo-Atherton proved why it is one of the top teams around when it blazed to a 44.0 clocking. Anchor man Bull Hatcher nipped Ravenswood's Tom Marlowe at the tape.

The 880 relay looked as though it was going to be a photo-finish between Ravenswood and M-A. With 300 yards left, Bear anchor Steve Mitchell aggravated a muscle pull and had to drop from the race and the Trojans had no other competition.

Jim Penrose and Jim Stolle led the Carlmont victories in the shot put and discus. Penrose tossed the shot 54-4¾ for his best effort of the 1967 campaign. Stolle became the third Carlmont discus tosser this season to break the 150 feet barrier. His heave of 151-0 was the best throw of the day.

In the high jump, Blair Morris of San Carlos and Oscar Jones of Ravenswood cleared 6-2. The mark is the best this season in the SPAL. Morris is only a class B jumper at San Carlos but moved up for the non-division relays to round-off the winning Don foursome.

Sequoia came up with a better effort than its last place finish in the team title. The Tribe's mile relay team won a convincing triumph but was disqualified for a lane violation. The Cherokees' 880 relay team was also disqualified for the same maneuver in a second place effort.

tied for second with Palo Alto at 1-0, at Sharon Heights. The Vikings will test Gunn, tied for third with Woodside with an 0-1 record, at Paly Muni, while last place Carlmont (0-2) tries to get into the victory column against Woodside at Emerald Hills.
