they travel to Mt. Pleasant High School for the Central Coast Section Track and Field Finals here Saturday.

Trials are scheduled to begin at 9 a.m.; finals will start around 1:30. The top three men in each event will qualify for the State Meet at San Diego June 2-3.

Palo Alto and Los Altos of the SCVAL are rated even money to capture the team title. The Vikings rest their hopes in discus thrower Winston Landes, miler Jon Enscoe, two-miler Tom Huntsberger, pole vaulter Mark Deitchman and high jumper Mark Daley.

Landes made the best throw in the state this season with a toss of 184-7/2 in last weekend's CCS Region I meet at Sequoia High and Enscoe clocked a fabulous 4:19.7 the same day.

The Sequoia District's biggest chance of landing a gold medal lies with Sequoia long jumper Charlie Johnson. Johnson has the second best leap in the CCS, 23-6 3/4. Grady Rogers of Homestead has a jump of 24-0 1/2 (wind-aided) to his credit.

Los Altos has a list of top sprinters, field performers and distance runners that makes

them a serious threat to cop the team crown.

Other top district cindermen who could place in the top three and earn a trip to San Diego include: Jim Penrose (Carlmont) in both the shot put and discus; Jim Portman (Sequoia) 120 high hurdles; Bill Hatcher (M-A) sprints and the only returning state meet competitor, Ben Welch of Woodside in the discus.

# Tribe, Scots Each Send Two To San Diego

SAN JOSE—While the runners were battling a gusty wind, the field performers were enjoying a very successful day in the Central Coast Section Track and Field Championships held at Mt. Pleasant High School Saturday.

Two of the field of participants who did not let the breezes bother them were Charlie Johnson of Sequoia and Jim Penrose of Carlmont, who both earned a trip to San Diego for the running of California State Championships Friday and Saturday.

Johnson garnered his berth via the long jump while Penrose came-through with a double-effort in the shot put and discus.

Carlmont and Sequoia will each have another representative in the Southland this weekend. Chris Carey tugged and floated to a first place finish in the two-mile (9:36.6) and Jim Portman took a surprise third in the 120 high hurdles with a time of 14.8 behind Mills' Randy White and Al Giacosa.

Johnson won the long jump with a leap of 24-7 1/2 while Penrose placed in the discus with a heave of 178-5 and in the shot with a toss of 55-5.

Other top field performances besides Johnson and Penrose included Steve Wilhelm's shot put of 63-8 1/2; Todd Peterson's (Los Altos) pole vault effort of 14-4 1/2 and Don McCullough's (San Lorenzo Valley) high jump mark of 6-7.

Palo Alto's Jon Enscoe finished first in the mile with a time of 4:24.5; Bill Respini nabbed a second place spot in the 880 (1:59.2) and Mark Daley took a second in the high jump (6-4) to represent Palo Alto in the State Meet.

The biggest surprise of the day was in the discus where Palo Alto's Winston Landes failed to qualify. Landes, who last week threw 184-7 1/2 for the best mark in California, tossed his platter some thirty feet short of his best.

Los Altos won the team championship with 27 points ahead of Capuchino, Mills, Cupertino and Carlmont.

The Knights displayed a lot of over-all power in the sprints and field events. Leading the way for LA was pole vaulter Peterson who leaped 14-4 1/2 for a lifetime best and Brad Lyman who won the 100 (9.7) and was a second place finisher in the 220.

# Los Altos Captures Spike Title

SAN JOSE (Special) — The field event performances overshadowed the runners as Los Altos captured its second straight Central Coast Section track and field title at wind-swept Mt. Pleasant High here yesterday.

Three of the four best marks were registered in the field events as a pesty wind halted all record-breaking in the CC sections qualifying runoff for State Meet berths.

The outstanding marks included a 14-4½ pole vault by Todd Peterson of champion Los Altos, a 63-8½ shot put heave by Fremont of Sunnyvale's Steve Wilhelm and a 24-7 long jump by Sequoia's multi-talented Charlie Johnson.

The best track performance was turned in by Gene Delk of Andrew Hill, who captured the 180 yard hurdles in a swift 18.6 seconds.
