'Numbers Game' Favors Knights

If sheer force of numbers has anything to do with it, Los Altos competitors should make their presence known at the Central Coast Section track and field championships Saturday at Mount Pleasant High School.

As a result of last Saturday's regional meets, the Knights earned 13 slots in the sectional and figure to do well in nearly all of the 10 events for which they qualified.

Brad Lyman will lead the contingent of Los Altos runners into the meet. In the Region II meet at Westmont over the weekend, Lyman won both the 100 and 220 dashes and was part of the Knight quartet that made a mockery of the 880 relay in 1:29.8.

In addition to Lyman and his running mates, there are three Los Altos weightmen rated high in the CCS meeting.

Ralph Pettingell, Steve Davis and Randy Beck all qualified for the championships of the shot put and Davis and Beck doubled as discus qualifiers.

Two of the better races of the meet should be the 100 and the 220.

Lyman and Santa Cruz' Byron Wilson, who qualified in the Region III meet at Gonzales, both have run 9.7 in the 100 and will be joined by several runners who have hit the 10-flat mark.

Lyman's top 220 time is 21.6

and is three-tenths of a second behind Wilson's CCS best.

Other events to watch are the long jump, which will pit Sequoia's Charlie Johnson (23-6 $\frac{3}{4}$) against Homestead's Grady Rogers (24-0 $\frac{1}{2}$), and the discus, where Davis and Beck will tangle with Winston Landes of Palo Alto.

Landes wiped out Davis' CCS season-high of 181-3 Saturday with a throw of 184-7 $\frac{1}{2}$. Beck and a few other entrants have recorded throws of 170 feet or better.
