

# McCullough Jumps 6-6; KC Wins Title

Pacific Grove — The King City varsity track team rolled up 66 points to capture the varsity championship in the Mission Trail Athletic League's Track championships here yesterday.

Dennis McCullough of San Lorenzo Valley set a new MTAL high jump mark as he cleared 6'6", which topped the old mark of 6'2½" which was set in 1964.

Jim Helmer of the Cougar lightweight team took a second in the mile a third in the shot put and captured a third in the 440 yard run.

The lightweight division was won by Gilroy, which amassed 84 points in their win.

Thursday the MTAL held its consolation meet at Gilroy and the Hollister team took the var-

sity section as they collected 58½ to tie with King City.

The Hollister lightweights also took top honors in the losers meet as they came up with 60 points. San Lorenzo Valley scored 31½ points in the varsity competition while the Cougar lightweights collected 15.

CARMEL — King City High School rolled up 66 points here Saturday to win the 1967 Mission Trail League track and field championship.

The closest competition came

In the B division Gilroy won with 84 points to 60 for King City and 44 for Gonzales.

King City's Dan Short was the varsity division's only double winner. He took the 440 in :50.5 and the 220 in :23.1.

Bill McCullough of San Lorenzo Valley had the best mark of the meet as he leaped 6-6 in the high jump. Bob Kough of Live Oak got his season's best in the pole vault with a 13-4 effort.

King City also had the lightweight division's only double

winner. Lauro Diaz won the high jump with a leap of 5-9 and the pole vault with an 11-foot effort.
