Other area varsity qualifiers include Bayard Smith, second in the 440; Don Lowery, fourth in the 180 low hurdles, and Walt Edwards in the discus. All are from Santa Cruz which also qualified its relay squad composed of Lowery, Roy Dierflinger, Smith and Wilson.

White won the 180 low hurdles in 21.4 and the 100 in 10.5 in the "B" division.

Other Soquel qualifiers included Frank Adkinson, second in the high hurdles; Roy Hooten, third in the pole vault and high jump, and Harry Nervino, fourth in the 880.

George Hightower took a fourth in the 2-mile and Ken Gregory placed fourth in the discus for Santa Cruz.
