Greetings:

It's time once again to consider ticket needs for the major outdoor track meets. I'm sorry this request comes so early, but in order to insure the best possible block of tickets at each of these events we must get going.

To those correspondents and friends who assist T&FN with the timing and picking of places in these meets, we offer a courtesy service to purchase tickets through us so that we are able to sit in a block of seats--reasonably near the finish.

Quite frankly, at this early date we do not know the prices of tickets but in virtually every case we will purchase the most expensive. However, if you can plan sufficiently ahead and would like to attend some of these meets with T&FN (and punch your stopwatch as a member of our timing crew), let us know how many tickets you desire for which meets. We request that you hold the number to a minimum. For obvious reasons, you will be responsible for any tickets you request at this time. We will collect money at a later date.

We need your response soonest, and at the latest by March 28. The next time you will hear from any one re tickets is when they are delivered.

SAC Relays, Walnut, Calif., Apr. 26-27; West Coast Relays, Fresno, May 10-11 (primarily the 11th); AAWU, Berkeley, May 17-18; California Relays, Modesto, May 25; California State High School championships, May 31-June 1; PAAAU Championships, Hayward, May 30 (Memorial Day); San Diego Invitational, San Diego, May 31 (note change in dates with Coliseum-Compton Invitational); NCAA College Division, Hayward, June 7-8; USTFF, Fresno, June 7-8; Compton-Coliseum, Los Angeles, June 7 or 8; NCAA, Berkeley, June 13-14-15; AAU, Sacramento, June 20-21 (Thursday, Friday); Olympic Semi-Trials, Los Angeles, June 29-30.
