

# CYCLONES BOW TO NORTHERN

CEDAR FALLS, IA. — Larry White won the 100 and 220-yard dashes and ran the second leg on the record-setting 440-yard relay team as Northern Iowa defeated Iowa State, 94-51, Wednesday in track.

White captured the 100 in 10.3 seconds and ran the 220 in :22.2. The :42.3 clocking in the 440 relay was one of six records to fall. The old mark was :42.5.

The Panthers swept 13 of 16 events in boosting their dual meet mark to 3-0.
