
# SAN JOSE STATE INVITATIONAL

- 440 Relay: Very Strong. Toss all six names in a hat, draw. out four, and SJS should come out the winner. Newcomers Sam Davis and Ronnie Smith join five returnees in Lee Evans, Frank Slaton, Bob Griffin, and John Bambury as prime candidates.
- Mile Run: Strong. Three blue chip newcomers give the Spartans unusual depth here. Jim Adkins has the best outdoor mark of 4:09.9 while Pete Santos hit 4:08.2 indoors this season and has a 4:10.9 outdoor mark to his credit. Darold Dent brings his 4:10.7 along with lettermen Charlie August at 4:13 and Dave Barni at 4:20 to provide strength.
- 120 HH: Improved. Rickey Rogers holds the school record at 14.0 but must become more consistent. Larry Melquiond (14.3) is a questionmark due to back surgery last spring. Could use more depth so look for freshman Jerroll Dolphin (14.6) to move up as season progresses.
- 440 Dash: Exteremely Strong. The world's top quartermiler, Lee Evans, is back with career bests of 44.9m and 45.3y. He was rated number one by Track and Field News after winning 18 of his 22 quarter miles in 1967. Victor at the AAU and Pan Am Games before being slowed by an August injury. Two men at 47.5 provide great depth-Paul Myers and Jack Malloy. Then comes John Bambury at 48.0 and Jeff Peo at 48.5.
- 100 Dash. Strong. Two proven 9.4 men, Sam Davis and Ronnie Smith, are the leaders. Bob Griffin (9.5) seems to have shaken an injury-plagued junior year and Frank Slaton (9.7) is an improving sophomore. John Bambury also is a possibility here.
- 880 Run: Strong. Transfers again spell promise in an event that has been lacking during past years at SJS. Jack Malloy (1:49.8) was second in the state JC meet last spring while Paul Myers (1:50.8) was fourth. Newcomer Dave Funderburk (1:54.0) is a solid performer.
- 440 IH: Questionable. No proven performers although transfer Larry Walls (53.9) is improving. High hurdler Rickey Rogers (53.9) is unfamiliar here but must master the intermediates in a hurry.
- 220 Dash: Strong. Everyone here is a sub-21.4 man so SJS rates a solid threat. Best time is held by Lee Evans (20.7) but he won't concentrate on this event leaving it up to Ronnie Ray Smith (20.9), Bob Griffin (21.0), John Bam-

- bury (21.1), Sam Davis (21.3), and Frank Slaton (21.4) to win dual meet points.
- Two Mile Run: Strong. Two potential first place men hold forth in sophomore Ralph Gamez (8:53.4) and Darold Dent (9:01.4) with improvement expected from transfer Ted Lydon (9:20) and letterman Byron Lowry (9:20), the latter has been slowed the past year with various ailments but appears recovered and ready for a strong showing.
- Mile Relay: Strong. The word strong may be an understatement what with a main cog returning from the American Record setting foursome of 1967. Lee Evans is back and will be the anchor man. The other three slots will be filled by either Jack Malloy, John Bambury, Paul Myers or Jeff
- Pole Vault: Strong. Unusual depth here with Pre-Olympic winner Chris Papanicolaou (17-41/4) backed by transfers Bob Slover (16-3) and Dearl Thomas (15-63/4). Papanicolaou feels 18 feet is a distinct possibility soon.
- Long Jump. Improved. The best two men here concentrate in other fields but must produce in dual meets. Rickey Rogers has hit 24-11 and Sam Davis 24-61/2. Regular jumpers Howard Butler (23-113/4) and Ellis Williams (23-9) need to improve those marks.
- Shot Put: Weak. Randy Raus (54-43/4) should improve but has only Nick Brautovic (54-0) to back him up. Look for freshman Rick Bilotti (57-8 HS) to perform for the varsity.
- Javelin: Improved. Rich Arcide is right around his official best of 231-4 in practice runs the past year but must put everything together this year. Paul Hewitt, out with eye problems last year, has tossed 224-0 when healthy.
- High Jump: Same. Transfer Don Lindsey (6-101/2) and 1966 letterman Terry Doe (6-101/2) must carry the Spartans here. Three freshmen all show potential-Bruce Washburn (6-7), Darrell Hillman (6-6) and Al Graves (6-5).
- Discus: Improved, Transfer John Powell (164-1) is the best followed closely by Nick Brautovic (163-0), transfer Fred Hayden (159-0) and letterman Bob Twelvetrees (159-0) plus Randy Raus (155-0).
- Triple Jump: Weak. Howard Butler (47-3) and Ellis Williams (47-2) have to improve on their marks. Transfer Aldo Donnolia (47-8) must help.





#### SPARTAN TRACK STAFF

#### Coach Bud Winter

"Builder of Champions" may sound corny or overworked, but how else can one describe the effervescent and highly successful Bud Winter, track coach at San Jose State.

Now in his 24th year as head man for the Spartans, he has turned out world record holders in his specialty, the sprints; toured the world conducting clinics, coaching and consulting; written training books, and made a film for world-wide use on sprinting.



In 20 of these 24 seasons at SJS, the Spartans have scored in the NCAA championship meet, including a present string of 12 straight years.

He's turned out 24 individual and two relay national champions, eight Olympic performers in the past five games, three runnerup teams in the NCAA, two USTFF runnerup teams and many AAU individual titlists.

A highlight of Bud's career came in 1960 when he was selected as an assistant coach for the U.S. Olympic track team that performed in Rome.

Recently he assisted the Jamaicans with their Olympic Development Program, also helping institute a five-year sports plan to aid in curbing juvenile delinquency as well as develop Olympic talent.

He served as a track consultant to the Mexico Organizing Committee for the upcoming Games and held a similar position during Japan's 1964 Olmpics.

In the summer of 1966 he conducted clinics and coached for the Rumanian government and visited the athletic federations and Olympic committees of Yugoslavia, Denmark and Switzerland.

During 1964's Olmpics, Winter was host of the international coach's conclave in Tokyo and was one of four coaches honored for his contributions to track with an Olympic gold medal.

Bud is past president of the American College Track Coaches Association and in 1956 was chairman of the first State Department on a world-wide tour, during which he International Track Coaches Clinic. He has represented the devoted much time conducting clinics in India.

Winter has written four books titled "Rocket Start", "Jet Sprint Relay Pass", "So You Want to be a High Jumper", and "So You Want to be a Sprinter".

Before coming to SJS, where he also assisted in football during the early 1950's Bud was a winning coach at Watsonville High and the then—Salinas (Hartnell) JC in both track and football.

#### Assistant Ted Banks



Ted Banks, fast developing a reputation as a builder of championship - caliber teams, is in his first year as assistant track coach and cross country head at San Jose State.

This is his first venture into coaching in the fouryear school ranks, coming to SJS from Pasadena City College.

At Pasadena, he brought the school its first-ever cross country conference championship and the first track title in 30 years.

Banks was at PCC three years, after six years in the Southern California high school coaching ranks.

He turned out two Western Conference titlists in cross country, was fourth in the state and Southern California in 1965 and third in the state and second in Southern California in 1966.

In track, PCC racked up three straight WSC crowns under Ted. All middle and long distance records were lowered each year Banks was at PCC. He also coached two national junior college record holders: pole vaulter Dick Railsback (16-5½) in 1965 and a 440-yard relay team (40.9) in 1965.

A 1956 graduate of UCLA, Banks received his Masters in Health Education from Los Angeles State in 1966.

Banks coached at Alhambra High from 1959 through 1962 and had a runnerup cross country team and placed one mid-distance runner in each CIF meet.

Next came one year as head man at La Puente High, with league cross country championships at each high school level. From here he spent a year at La Habra High, with a cross country title in three divisions and a third spot in the CIF being the fruits.

Ted also coached the pasadena Athletic Association team in 1966. He and his wife, Judith Irene, reside in San Jose with their daughter, Jennifer, 3.

#### New \$225,000 All Weather Track

San Jose State track athletes begin the 1968 season performing on the ultimate in running surfaces— Tartan—made by Minnesota Mining and Manufacturing (3M).

At a cost of \$225,000, Spartan track fans will see top flight times recorded on the same surface that is being installed in Mexico City for the 1968 Summer Olympics.

Tartan is a rubberized compound that is poured out over an asphalt base and is 3/8 inch thick.

The San Jose oval is nine lanes for the complete 440 yard circumference and no such facility in Northern California can boast that number of lanes for a complete lap.
