

Sequoia 3rd In Track Relay Meet

SAN JOSE — Two strong relay efforts gave Sequoia High a third place in the Blossom Hills Relays track carnival at Leigh High here Saturday.

The Cherokees' 880-yard relay team of Chris Hoff, Darryl White, Barr Curry and Tim O'Connor took a first in 1:31.7 and White, O'Connor and Greg and Don Willis placed second in the mile relay at 3:25.3. White went 50.8 and O'Connor 50.2 for their legs on the mile relay.

Byron Woodside added a fifth in the discus as the Cherokees tallied 19 points. Homestead walked away with the top honors with 72 points, with Logan second at 20. All of Logan's points came in the B's, making Sequoia the second best varsity squad among the 49 schools.

Bill Hatcher won the 100-yard dash in 10.1 over a slow track to pace Menlo-Atherton to fourth place with 18 points.

Hatcher upset South San Francisco's Russ Cottrell in the race. Teammate Ernie Reese placed fifth in the 100 at 10.3, while the M-A Class B 880 relay team of Ron Feibusch, Conrad Everhardt, Jim Lewis and Raphael Caunday missed a win by one-tenth of a second, crossing the line in 1:34.5 for second place.

M-A's B two-mile relay quartet of Jim Lewis, Tom Lodato, Bob Barrett and Tom Boeddiker was fourth.

Palo Alto finished 15th in the field on the strength of Mark Daley's first place in the high jump with a 6-3 $\frac{3}{4}$ leap and Bob Thorup's third in the shot put.

San Carlos' mile relay team placed fourth and St. Francis' distance medley team fifth for other area placers.
