King City got a first place out of Sam Albanese in the pole vault to help its third place finish. Albanese cleared 13-6 to beat Palma's Mark Lavagnino who made 13 feet.

Palma's Lewis won the high hurdles in :15.2 to go along with his second place finish in the high jump to spark the Chieftain effort. Palma's biggest disappointment of the day came when pole vaulter Dave Garibay, who cleared 14 feet last week, failed to place in that event.

A second place finish by Salinas High School's Cowbabes paced Salinas area participation in Saturday's Central Coast Section, region III lightweight qualifying meet on the Alisal High track.

The Cowbabes scored 33 points to 41 for champion Watsonville. Seaside was also close with a total of 31 points.

Leading Salinas were Joe Baxter, Glen Walder, Kirk Maness and Jeff Ogawa.

Baxter took the discus with a throw of 132-11 and was second in the shot put at 48-13/4. Walder won the 880 in 2:07.9. Maness took the two mile in 10:28.7 and Ogawa continued his domination of lightweight shot putting with a toss of 48-7 1/2, well below his best.

The individual star of the meet, however, was Palma's Shawn Cassady. Cassady took both the high jump and pole vault with leaps of 5 7/8 and 12 feet respectively.
