District Track Trials:

Records for Penrose

Carlmont's Jim Penrose set a pair of meet records in leading the weight throwing qualifiers in the Sequoia District Track and Field trials at Terremere Field Tuesday afternoon.

Penrose's discus throw of 174-11, although not nearly as good as his state best toss of 180-8½

in El Cerrito Saturday, broke former Woodside star Ben Welch's meet record of 174-6.

The Scot senior set another mark when he shattered Larry Kennedy's eight-year record of 55-7¾ in the shot put with a lifetime best heave of 58-1.

Penrose and Tuesday's other qualifiers will shoot for higher marks in Friday's finals at Terremere Field, beginning at 7:30 p.m. with the C two-mile and field events.

The first running event will take place at 8 o'clock after honorary meet referee Edward E. Kaufman is introduced to the crowd. Kaufman, the vice-principal of Sequoia High, is the man most responsible for the re-

cent improvements at Terremere Field.

The varsity team title will be a three-way struggle between Carlmont, Menlo-Atherton and Sequoia. The Scots led Tuesday's qualifying with 21 places for Friday's finals.

Carlmont, undefeated dual meet champion, will have to fight off Sequoia (18 qualifiers) and Menlo-Atherton (14). The latter suffered a serious blow Thursday when sprinter Ernie Reese was injured in the last dual meet of the season. He pulled a leg muscle and will miss Friday's finals.

The loss of Reese may cost Menlo-Atherton the 440 relay title and places in both sprints.

The relay teams and mile and two-mile participants did not have to qualify in all divisions.
