ACC frosh Roger Colglazier suffered his first loss of the season in the 440 dash when he finished second to Texas A&M's Curtis Mills in the special Drake Relays quarter. Colglazier ran 46.6 as he went through his first 220 in 21.4. "That's just too fast," said Coach Bill McClure.

Ronnie Crawford, running his first open 440 of the year, had a fine 47.3 for fourth place.

The Wildcat sprint relay team clocked 41.1 in a preliminary race at Drake for a seasonal best. The quartet of Monte Stratton, Bill Overly, Roger Colglazier and Robert Medlock placed sixth in the finals in 41.3.

Sophomore Mark Fry didn't make the trip to Drake due to an injury and his absence was felt on the mile relay. In the prelims McClure ran Clarence Grayer out of the block, with the sophomore running 49.3.
