Bruce Weberbauer, representing the New York Athletic Club, came from behind, and won the 14th Annual All-Around Weight Throwing Competition held by the New York Athletic Club on October 13, 1968 at Travers Island, Pelham Manor, New York. Weberbauer tallied 4,007 points, only three points more than the second place finisher, Richard Sherman of the Long Island Athletic Club. In last year's meet, also held at Travers Island, Weberbauer wound up in third place behind teammates Bob Mead and Ed Doernberger with an achievement of 3,612 points indicating a good improvement in this year's meet.

The meet record is 4,583 points set by Tom Pagani, also of the N. Y. A. C., in the 1963 meet held in Bayonne, New Jersey.

Sherman took the lead in the point scoring when he got off a good heave of 185 feet 8 inches in the hammer throw which was the second event on the program. He piled on more points by coping the next event, the discus throw, where he scaled the Grecian pie platter 156 feet 7 inches. At the end of this event Weberbauer was in third place. Sherman maintained his lead in the javelin throw but when it came to the 35-pound weight throw, Weberbauer threw a good 54 feet enabling him to overcome the leading Sherman and win the meet.

Bruce Weberbauer's other performances were 46 feet 11½ inches in the shot put, 169 feet 3 inches in the hammer throw, 149 feet in the discus and 151 feet 3½ inches in the javelin throw.

An outstanding performance was given by Milton Sonsky, competing unattached, when he hurled the javelin 236 feet 4 inches which was just short of the meet record he set last year of 240 feet 9 inches. George Allen of St. John's University won the shot put event with a performance of 53 feet 7 inches.
