Willie Davenport Sets Indoor Hurdles Record

BOSTON (UPI)-World Indoor records fell in the 45-yard high hurdles and 35-pound weight throw Saturday night in the 80th Boston A.A. track meet. Willie Davenport broke

his personal barrier in the hurdles when he hit the tape in 5.3 to crack the ofttied world indoor mark of 5.4 which he had equaled on several occasions.

The weight mark was chalked up in near privacy during the afternoon field events at Northeastern University, Long Beach weightlifter George Frenn scored with a heave of 73-31/2 inches to break Hal Connolly's nine-year-old record by more than two

A Boston Garden crowd of 11,095 also saw a meet record set in the two-mile run by Bob Finley of Toronto. He won in 8:37.2, 1.2 seconds better than the BAA mark by Kerry O'Brien of Australia two years earlier.

Sam Bair won the mile feature as expected with a time of 4:04.3 as he ran the last half mile without any

competition.

John Pennel of the Striders won the pole vault at 16-6, then missed at three bids for what would have been a Boston record of

Villanova's Larry James won a special 440 in 48.6 while Martin McGrady of Akron, Ohio, edged Benedict Cayenne of Maryland State and Trinidad in 1:10.9 in the 600-yard race.

Czechoslavakia's Plachy won the 1,000-yard test in 2:11.6 when he overtook Herb Germann of New York on the final lap to win going away.
