

# Cal Poly (SLO) Keeps CCAA Track Crown

Michael Mathyas scored the 880-mile double Saturday night, leading Cal Poly (SLO) to its second straight CCAA track title at Cal State (LA).

Mathyas bettered his seasonal best by a full second in both events. He led from wire-to-wire in a 4:11.6 mile victory but had to come from 10 yards back to win the half in 1:50.6.

Mathyas and Cal State (LA) sprinter Stan Allotey were the only double winners. Allotey set one of two conference records, in the 220—20.8.

Earlier Allotey came from behind after a poor start and took the 100 in a slow 9.8.

## Javelin Record

The other meet mark went to Valley State's javelin thrower Rolf Hoppe. Hoppe threw 244-1, bettering Cal Poly (Pomona) Frank San Filippo's year-old record of 237-1. San Filippo, who finished second, also bettered his old mark, throwing 242-6.

Hoppe also bettered his South American citizens record. The 21-year-old Fresno State thrower threw 237-6 two weeks ago.

Fresno State's Erkki Mustakari escaped disaster in the pole vault, clearing 16 feet on his final attempt to win. Mustakari passed until 15-4, cleared that height on his final attempt, and later failed in three attempts at 17-0.

Cal Poly (SLO) had a field day winning nine events and rolling up 97 points.
