

Cal Sets 3 Meet Marks Despite Rain, Cold

California's Bears, undeterred by rain, wind and cold, delivered their expected rout.

Paced by quick Jim Smith, the Bears ran away from Washington's depth-shy tjack team, 99-54, in a Pacific-8 before 300 cold, wet fans yesterday in Husky Stadium.

Three meet records were set, despite the adverse conditions.

California's Jim Fraser surpassed a 35-year-old mark with a winning long jump of 24 feet 2 1/4 inches. Washington's John Hubbell extended his own meet record with a shot put of 59-6 1/4. The Bears' Gary Pennington set a javelin standard of 229-9 1/2.

SMITH WON the 100-yard dash in 9.7 seconds; took the 220 in :21.7; ran a leg for California's winning 440-relay team and gave the Bears a come-from-behind victory in the mile relay with a :46.6 anchor lap.

Fraser added a quarter inch to the meet long-jump record of 24-2, set by California's Bob Clark in 1934. Hubbell eclipsed his shot mark of 58-8 1/2 set last year. Pennington bettered the javelin record of 229-7, established in 1968 by Washington's Don Fate.

day was 210-10 1/2. He finished Fate's best throw yesterday, behind Greg Brovold, teammate, who tossed the spear 219-1 1/2.

The defeat was the second in Pac-8 competition and fourth of the season for the Huskies. But there were some bright spots for Coach

Ken Shannon in his squad's "best team effort" to date.

The brightest wre Bill Smart's come-from-behind victories in the mile and 880; Marty Walsh's last-stride triumph in the 440 and Kim Hoelting's comeback win in the 440 hurdles.

SMART STARTED the last lap of the mile a stride behind California's Dennis Barley. The Husky junior surged ahead at the end of the backstretch and pulled out to win going away in 4:17.8 Barley was second in 4:24.3.

In the 880, Smart took command halfway down the backstretch and kicked out to a 15-yard victory over Lavell Jackson. Smart finished in 1:52.1, Jackson in 1:54.4.

Walsh, gaining steadily through the final 100 yards, got up to nip Randy Smyth at the wire in the 440. The Husky was timed in :50.2, a tenth of a second faster than Smyth.

Hoelting, a fast-improving junior, overtook Cal's Bob McLennan between the last two barriers of the intermediate hurdles and pulled out to a convincing victory. Hoelting's time, :52.4, was 1.5 seconds faster than McLennan's and 1.1 ahead of his previous best.

GREG MIGUEL, California pole vaulter who has cleared 16-6 1/2, failed to get off the ground in the strong wind which marred the early part of the meet. Washington's Jeff Bingham took first place with a vault of 14-0.

The Bears' Ted Ackley

outdid his favored teammate, Clarence Johnson, in the high jump. Ackley won at 6-6. Johnson and Washington's Harrison Wood shared second at 6-4.
