Dyce--perfect pace; I like a fast pace but I don't like to set it; this was great for me. I felt as long as I could stay on his shoulder (Mur) I could outkick him

Liq. wanted under four; but no one would set pace

James ran very fast first 110, made up three staggers by time he hit back stretch; reaky wasted, 20 min. later still gasping

I wanted to try something I'd never tried before; I really went into from the beginning; I think I can learn to run a faster first half of the race and finding out what its like

(will not run AAU at present--doesn't want to get on tour, going to summer school.

Murphy likely to run $\frac{1}{2}$ in NCAA,
