

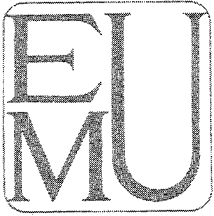

ELLIS LEADS HURON THINCLADS TO IMPRESSIVE SHOWING IN FIRST OUTDOOR COMPETITION

Dave Ellis, premier sophomore on the Eastern Michigan track team, showed the way for the Green and White at the University of Kentucky Relays Friday and Saturday, winning both the Six Mile and the Three Mile runs. Ellis copped the Six Mile title on Friday evening with a 28:54.3 clocking and came back on Saturday afternoon with a 13:58.1 effort over the Three mile distance.

EMU's Finnish triple-jumper, Kauko Ketolainen, garnered the Hurons' 3rd first place gold watch of the two-day meet with a 49' 4 3/4" marker in the finals. Ketolainen established a UK Relays triple-jump record in the qualifying leaps with a 50' 1/4" jump.

Three Huron varsity marks were broken during the meet; Ellis cracked Tony Mifsud's Six Mile mark of 30:43.2 set in 1966, junior Bill Kouvolo heaved the Javelin 201' 2" in qualifying to erase Tony Rasmovich's 1941 mark of 193' 1" (Kouvolo finished 5th in the finals with a 189' 1 1/2" effort) and Freshman Dave Campbell's 3rd place finish in the Steeplechase with a 9:13.6 clocking dropped Mauri Jormakka's 1960 time of 9:18.7 from the Huron varsity board.

The Hurons may have lost sophomore Bill Tipton for a while due to a stomach ailment. The fine young hurdler complained of stomach cramps just prior to the Sprint Medley Relay in which he was supposed to run and was returned to Ypsilanti Friday evening. He is undergoing further tests in a local hospital.

NAIA RECORD-SETTING MEDLEY RELAY QUARTET WILL SWIM IN NATIONAL AAU'S

Huron swimming coach Mike Jones has entered his crack Medley Relay quartet of Lester McCormick, Dennis Betts, Gordon Messer and Jeff Huxley in the National AAU meet being held in Long Beach, California this week.

This foursome established an NAIA record of 3:39.1 in the national championships held in Chicago on March 20-22. They will depart Wednesday, by plane, and swim on Thursday.

DIAMONDMEN HIT STRIDE EARLY

The Eastern Michigan baseball teams seems to have hit their stride early this season, winning their first two southern road-trip tilts in convincing fashion. The Hurons pounded West Virginia State 10-0 in the trip opener on April 3 and then out-duelled Brown University 4-1 on April 4.
