Los Angeles, Jan. 17 (From John Wenos) Despite several good early-season performances, the tenth annual Los Angeles Invitational "Champions" Meet was somewhat of a disappointment. The small crowd of 8105 had to be quite a letdown after seeing crowds of 10,000 - 15,000 in previous years. The absence of several big names also kept many good fields from becoming "super showdowns."

The missing indluded Mel Pender and Charlie Greene, who was snowbound in Omaha, in the 60; John Masson and Dave Patrick in the mile; Bob Beamon, who was forced to sit out the long jump with a pulled thigh muscle; and Bob Seagren, who was threatened with the loss of his last year of eligibility at USC if he competed in the non-NCAA sanctioned meet.

Ralph Doubell took "Athlete of the Meet" honors with a fast and convincing win over Wade Bell in the 1000. His time of 2:07.0 set a new meet record, missing Peter Snell's global mark by one second and left Bell over 20 yards back.

The biggest surprise in the two mile wasn't George Young's victory over Ron Clarke and Tracy Smith; the shocker was watching John Lawson stay with Young as the three-time Olympian kicked the final two laps and finish second only four-tenths behind. Clarke and Smith apparently fell victim to the slow early pace (4:26.5 mile).

Sam Bair took his third straight mile yitle of the still-young indoor season with a good 4:02.8. The other "class" runners in the field, Bob Day, Tom von Ruden, and Aussie George Scott couldn't stay with the former Kent State Star's blistering kick.

Willie Davenport tied the meet and Sports Arena record with his first 7.0 clocking of the year in the 60 high hurdles. Fast-improving Gary Powers surprised with a 7.1 second place finish.

Neal Steinhauer continued his indoor mastery of George Woods with a  $64-4\frac{2}{4}$  shot put win. Woods, Jay Silvester, and Bruce Wilhelm all bettered 62 feet.

The loudest cheers of the evening went to Masters distance champion Peter Mundle. The over-40 answer to Ron Clarke demolished the Seniors Mile record by 21.3 seconds with an amazing 4:31.6. RESULTS


