Michigan State Relays

East Lansing, Mich., Feb. 8--Jim Ryun returned to competition for the first time in nearly four months since the Olympics, but had to share attention with a newcomer to world class track, Bill Wehrwein.

~~_____~~ Wehrwein, 20-year-old Michigan State junior, won the 600 at the Michigan State Relays in 1:09, a world best for a 220-yard flat (dirt) track. His time matched Martin McGrady's record for Louisville's barked 220 boards in 1966 and fell short ~~only~~ ^{and Les Miller's 1:08.9} only of Hardee McAlhaney's 1:08.1 at Houston.

Ryun won the mile for the third straight year, in 4:06.2. He hung in third place until well into the final quarter, passing the three quarters in 3:11.5. Then he sprinted a little more than the final 220 and beat Ralph Schultz by more than 20 yards.

"This race was a lot of fun," he said. "More fun than they had been for a while. I was surprised it was that fast. I've trained only five days indoors and my work outdoors has been consistent --anything from 80 miles a week to nothing at all."

Kansas dominated the meet with seven victories, three of them meet records.
