(Kansas City, Mo., Jan. 24-25--Eastern Michigan dominated middle and long distance running events, thanks largely to six non-US athletes, to smash the NAIA field with 96 1/3 points and set three meet records. Prairie View ~~Arm~~ Edged Arkansas AM&N for second, 52-47 1/3.

(Victorious coach Bob Parks) ~~snaring his first indoor title in the four year history of this meet, has recruited a fine stable of 440-880 sprinters.~~ Parks has a friend in the Peace Corps, stationed at Trinidad, who does parttime scout work for the Ypsilanti, Mich., school. Three Trinadians scored 26 points: Eric Nesbitt, voted athlete of the meet, won the 1000 <sup>(2:12.5)</sup> in leading two teammates <sup>(2nd and 4th)</sup> to ~~places~~, and anchored ~~his record setting~~ two-mile relay quartet to victory; Patrick Bynoe, won the 600 after setting a record of 1:12.3 in the prelims, and Keith Swanston who sprinted to 4th in the 60 and finished 6th in the long jump.)

Commonwealth athletes added 17 1/2 more to Eastern Michigan's total, as Olympian Dave Ellis (5000-10,000m) took Westmont's surprising Dennis Savage in the 24-lap two-mile, 8:55.0-8:56.6. Roger Trumbly, a Canadian like Ellis, scored in the 880 and two-mile relay, and Aussie David Campbell backed up Ellis with a 4th in the two-mile.

(Overall the meet lacked fast times but afforded the crowd of 6155 with exciting, competitive races. Two notable absentees were Texas Southern and Southern, both competing at Houston. ~~Prep hurdling sensation of 1967, Bill Tipton, returned from leg injuries of a year ago to cop the 69-yard high event for Eastern Michigan.~~

(John Mason, who has finally completed his eligibility at Ft. Hays, St., Kansas, topped a field which included three Olympians with a 4:06.7 clocking in the ~~Open~~ Mile. Ray Haswell of Canada was a second behind, with ~~too short~~ for him Van Nelson at 4:09.4 and veteran Jozef Odlozil of Czechoslovakia 4th. (4:09.7).)

(Bobby Brown of Arkansas AM&N, who sped a 5.9 behind Jim Hines <sup>here</sup> last year, flashed to a 6.1 in the preliminary round, to be matched later by Winston Shortt and Tom Griffith. Andy Steben of Oxy won his <sup>palmsult</sup> 3rd straight title at 15:16"
