Highlights of Ohio Valley Conference Meet (Bowling Green, Ky.) (Nolan Fowler)

Fastrac used on track and runways.

May 16 : Rainy, with wind blowing against runners in 100 and highs. Temperature in 60's.

Henry Jackson (Wky) had a great day. Won high jump from a rainy surface in $6-7\frac{3}{4}$, won long jump, wind-aided, with $25-10\frac{1}{2}$, ran anchor on 440-yard relay team that did 0:42.3, and won heat in 100 into strong breeze with 0:10.0. (Probably a rolling start, though). Had another wind-aided leap of $25-7\frac{3}{4}$. But even though he was jumping from a Fastrac surface, the rain made matters slippery.

Wilbur Davis, Eastern Kentucky, had 24-6 but this leap was probably wind-aided, too. No anemometer present.

Tommye Turner ran a 0:46.6 anchor on mile relay in a driving rain.

May 17 : Cloudy, wind blowing again in same direction. In 70's.

Grant Colhour, Eastern Kentucky senior, had a fine double. Won mile in 4:08.1, and then won 3-mile easily in 14:03.4.

Darrell Remole (Monroe) was 2nd in mile with 4:09.0, Darrell Myers (Wky) 3rd with 4:09.2,

Tommie ("T-Bird") Turner (Murray) also had a respectable double — 0:46.5 in quarter and 0:21.2 in 220.

Henry Jackson (Wky) continued his great jumping with a 52-2³/₄ in triple jump. It was not wind-aided and, furthermore, it was in a pit that was level. This makes him #2 in nation(?)

He ran anchor in winning 440-yard relay team, which did 0:44.4. He finished the day with 3rd in the 100. Time for him was 0:10.1 into wind.

Wilbur Davis (EKy) had a near-record one-day double (maybe he did have a record; I do not have a copy of the Portuguese tables) in the triple jump, 46-1 (no wind) and 15-7 in the vault. He was 5th in the triple jump and winner of vault.

Middle Tennessee, anchored by Jerry Singleton with 0:46.1, won mile relay in 3:10.5. Western Kentucky ran 3:12.6.

Bob Stoltman (Wky) tossed discus 173-¹/₂.
Sam Pearson (Wky) took 440 IH in 0:53.3.
