Greek's 17-1½ Vault Tops Meet At MC

A couple of gold medalists failed to make the starting gates Saturday night but after the introductions they weren't greatly missed by a standing-room crowd of 9,744 that turned out for the ninth annual Oregon Invitational Indoor meet.

There was enough 14-carat talent in that field to satisfy any fan; enough to erase four meet marks, match a couple more and keep the crowd on tippy-toe most of the evening.

Generally, one record is no

better than another, but this time judges took exception. They presented the meet's "Outstanding Athlete Award" to Chris Papanicalaou of San Jose State, who soared 17-1 to establish a new meet and Coliseum record in the pole vault.

Papanicalaou succeeds Altti Alarotu of Brigham Young, who won in 1968 with a 17-0 jump and begged off this year with a torn Achilles tendon.

For which the public address announcer may be forever thankful. Imagine his predicament had Papanicalaou and Alarotu tied for first.

Records also fell in the special mile as Oregon's Steve Savage turned in a 4:11.2; in the 60-yard open hurdles to George Carty, San Jose State, 7.0, and in the high school mile.

Steve Prefontaine of Marshall took care of the prep mark. He didn't exactly shatter it — 4:13.5 against Roscoe Divine's old record of 4:13.8 — but he literally demolished the field. After a half-mile, Prefontaine was running alone. By the final lap he was
