

Jerry Williams' Two Firsts Can't Outrun Princeton

Princeton—Two wins by Penn captain Jerry Williams were not enough to prevent Princeton from topping the Quakers and Columbia in the Polar Bear Track Meet for the tenth straight year. The final score was Princeton 72, Penn 57, Columbia eight.

Williams won the mile by 35 yards in 4:09, and eked out a one-yard victory in the 1,000-yard run, but the Tigers captured eight of the 13 events to boost their indoor record to 7-1.

Eamon Downey gained his third victory in a row with a 9:05 clocking in the two-mile to pace Princeton. Chris Lambertson set a Penn record of 58-8 in winning the 35-pound weight throw. The Quakers are now 3-3.
