and finished second in the other two.

Dyce was an overwhelming choice as the outstanding athlete of the meet. Last week, he was voted the top college athlete in the Penn Relays.

Sunny, 79-degree weather and a soft breeze contributed to the fine performances as five records were set. One record was tied when Barry Brown of the New York Athletic Club matched his winning effort of last year in the 3,000 meter steeplechase with an 8 minute 51.6 second clocking today.

Milton Barry Sonsky, a 27-year-old Brooklyn bachelor and teacher, broke his own meet mark in the javelin by more than four feet. Sonsky's toss of 260 feet 2 inches tied his best effort of the season, was the fourth best by an American in the event this year and was one of the longest in the East.

Other meet records went to Dave Romansky in the one-mile walk (6:31.2), Peter Chen in the pole vault (16 feet 2 3/4 inches) and Willye White in the women's long jump (1-10 1/2).

One world record also was established, by Mamie Rallins of the Mayor Daley Youth Foundation, in a new event, the women's 100-meter hurdles in 14.1 seconds.

Villanova's two-mile record of 7 minutes 26 seconds was set despite the absence of Frank Murphy, the Wildcats' usual anchorman. Exams also kept three members of the mile relay and two members of the sprint medley on the campus.

Yet even the presence of Villanova in the 2-mile relay could not detract from Dyce's exploits. The Wildcats led by 15 yards in the race when Marty Liquori, their sophomore Olympian, took the baton for the last half-mile.

Liquori Maintains Margin

Dyce methodically closed the gap on Liquori until the margin was seven yards on the backstretch of the last lap. But Liquori maintained his edge and
