 * CAPTAIN LEE EVANS *
 *
 * Double Olympic gold medal winner Lee Evans, *
 * the present holder of seven world records, is the *
 * 1969 Spartans' team captain. *
 * Evans, who won the 400 meter national NCAA *
 * and AAU titles last season, set a world mark of *
 * 43.8 in the 400 meters and anchored the United *
 * States 1600 meter relay team to a world record of *
 * 2:56.1 at Mexico City last fall. *
 * For his outstanding performance in 1968, *
 * Evans was selected by Track and Field News as the *
 * U.S. College Athlete of the Year. *
 * Despite having to overcome enormous margins *
 * at times, Evans lost only twice--in two inconsequ- *
 * ential races--in 19 finals prior to the Olympic *
 * Games. *
 * Evans also holds the American record in the *
 * 600 meters with a time of 1:14.3 which he set at *
 * Lake Tahoe last summer during the Olympic Trials. *

SPARTAN NOTES

San Jose State owns every world sprint record with the exception of the 100-yard dash and the 440-yard relay . . . Gold medalist RONNIE RAY SMITH, JOHN CARLOS, Bronze Medal winner, and newcomer KIRK CLAYTON will have a say about adding these two events to the Spartans' sparkling collection of world standards . . . LEE EVANS, who may see more duty in the 880 this season, will be tough to beat in the 440 . . . middle distance strength will come from NEVILLE MYTON and JACK MALLOY . . . mile and two mile could be strongest in recent years with RALPH GAMEZ, JIM ADKINS, DAROLD DENT, and ANDY VOLLMER heading the card . . . also figured to come up with their share of victories in the sprints are SAM DAVIS and AL HARRIS . . . GEORGE CARTY, SAM CARUTHERS and LARRY WALLS make a tough hurdle crew . . . possibility of becoming first college with three 17-foot pole vaulters in CHRIS APANICOLAOU, Greek Olympian, BOB SLOVER and CARUTHERS--all southpaws . . . two seven-foot high jumpers loom in DARNELL HILLMAN and DON LINDSEY . . . first 60-foot shot putter in school's history could be RICHARD MARKS, an Olympic weight-lifter on the side . . . MARION ANDERSON, DAVIS, GEORGE GAGE, LEE NEUMAN and ADRIAN PORTER top the field in the long jump and triple jump . . . JOHN POWELL heads a fine group of discusmen including FRED HAYDEN and newcomer TOM WILSON . . . JOHN HOLLIDAY along with DAN MAY are promising javelin throwers . . .

A true "Builder of Champions", Bud Winter is now celebrating his Silver Anniversary as head track coach at San Jose State.

In his 25 years at San Jose State Winter has turned out world record holders in his specialty, the sprints; toured the world conducting clinics, coaching and consulting; written training books, and made a film for world-wide use on sprinting.

In 21 of these 25 seasons at San Jose State, the Spartans have scored in the NCAA championship meet, including a present string of 13 straight years.

This year Track and Field News has picked the Spartans to win the National Crown.

Winter has turned out 26 individual and two relay national champions, 14 Olympic performers in the past five games, three runnerup teams in the NCAA, two USTFF runnerup teams and many AAU individual titles.

A highlight of Bud's career came in 1960 when he was selected as an assistant coach for the U.S. Olympic track team that performed in Rome.

He has assisted the Jamaicans with their Olympic Development Program, also helping institute a five-year sports plan to aid in curbing juvenile delinquency as well as develop Olympic talent.

He served as a track consultant to the Mexico Organizing Committee for the 1968 Olympic Games and held a similar position during Japan's 1964 Olympics.

In the summer of 1966 he conducted clinics and coached for the Rumanian government and visited the athletic federations and Olympic committees of Yugoslavia, Denmark and Switzerland.

During the 1964 Olympics he was host of the international coach's conclave in Tokyo and was one of four coaches honored for his contributions to track with an Olympic gold medal.

Bud is past president of the American College Track Coaches Assn. and in 1956 was chairman of the first International Track Coaches Clinic. He has represented the State Department on a world-wide tour, during which he devoted much time conducting clinics in India.

Winter has written four books titled: "Rocket Start", "Jet Sprint Relay Pass", "So You Want To Be A High Jumper", and "So You Want To Be A Sprinter".

Prior to coming to San Jose State, where he also served as assistant football coach during the early 1950's, Bud was a winning coach at Watsonville High and the then--Salinas (Hartnell) Junior College in both track and football.

Bud would like nothing better than to celebrate his 25th anniversary by winning the 1969 NCAA title--but the road to Knoxville, Tenn. is a long one with many hidden curves. Bud knows this, he's been on it before.

AND HIS ASSISTANT . . .

Ernie Bullard is in his first season as assistant track and field coach and head cross country coach at San Jose State.

He was appointed last fall to replace Ted Banks who assumed the position of head track coach at Grossmont High in San Diego.

Prior to coming to San Jose State Bullard, 31, coached at Mesa Community College where he led his team to second place in the 1967 National Junior College Athletic Association championships--the first year the school was in operation.

Last year his team captured the NJCAA title and set two national junior college records in the process. En route to the crown Mesa Community College won every relay and major meet in its division in California.

Bullard, who received his Bachelor of Arts Degree from the University of Southern California in 1959 and his Masters of Arts Degree from Arizona State in 1961, was head track coach at Orange Coast Junior College in Costa Mesa for three years (1964-65-66) prior to his appointment in Arizona.

His 1966 cross country team at Orange Coast JC won the Eastern Conference and Southern California championships and placed fourth in the JC State Meet.

He served as an assistant track coach at Arcadia High in 1962 and 1963 where his teams lost only four dual meets in that span and developed a State shot put prep champ in the person of Rich Blakely (59-10).

Now he's got his eye on Richard Marks, a weight-lifter who shows great promise of becoming San Jose State's first 60-foot shot putter.

\$225,000 ALL-WEATHER TRACK

San Jose State track and field athletes compete on the ultimate in running surfaces--Tartan--made by Minnesota Mining and Manufacturing (3M).

At a cost of \$225,000, Spartan track fans have been able to see top flight times recorded on the same surface that was installed in Mexico City for the 1968 Summer Olympics.

The track surface was christened last year.

Tartan is a rubberized compound that is poured out over an asphalt base and is 3/8 inch thick.

The San Jose State oval is nine lanes for the complete 440 yard circumference and no such facility in Northern California can boast that number of lanes for a complete lap.
