**Oleson Wins Mile; Laird Sets Two Walk Marks**

USC's Ole Oleson fought off Richard Carr's closing rush to win the mile in his best time ever, 4:03.0 in the SPAAU track championship's Friday night at Occidental.

Ron Laird celebrated his 31st birthday a day early, smashing his own American 5,000-meter and three-mile walk records.

Laird cut 16 seconds off his 5,000 mark of 21:49.8, turning in a 21:33.8. He was timed at 20:49.4 at the three-mile mark, bettering his 1966 American record of 21:03.8.

Only one other record was set—by Valley JC's Mark Covert who placed second in the six-mile to Santa Paula High School's Chuck Smead. Smead was timed in 29:25.8, Covert in 29:32.4 which established a national junior college record. The old mark was 29:41.2 by John Hayes of Tacoma JC in 1968.

Pepperdine sprinter Lorenzo Russell, competing for the Striders, was the meet's only double winner. Russell won the 100 in 9.7 and the 220 in 21.2.

USC shot putter Dave Murphy, who has thrown 60-7 this season fouled out and the Army's Carl Wallin won with a toss of 59-5.
