

Tribe Takes Stephen F. Title

NACADOCHES, Tex. (Special) — Northeast's Indians won half of the 16 events here Saturday afternoon to notch their second straight victory in the Stephen F. Austin Relays.

Final scores had Northeast with 90 points, Stephen F. Austin with 62½, Southwest Texas 49½, East Texas State 33, Sam Houston 19, Oklahoma Baptist 11 and McMurray 5.

Sylvester McKinney was the top performer in the meet rack-

ing up 11½ points with wins in the 100 and 220 - yard dashes plus running legs on the Indians' mile and sprint relays. McKinney had a 9.9 time in the century and 21.9 in the 220.

Other double winners for

Northeast were Richard Polk and John Hollingsworth.

Hollingsworth took firsts in the shot put and the discus. He set a new meet record in the discus with a toss of 166 - 1¼. Hollingsworth fired the shot 49-

4 to win by two feet over his nearest rival. The discus mark was a new career record for Hollingsworth.

Polk won the 120 - yard high hurdles in 15.4 and the 440-intermediate hurdles in 55.3.

Northeast Coach Bob Grose-close said, "I'm especially proud of our mile relay because our time is better than last year's and the splits were especially good for Jeff Rowdon (48.3) and freshman Joe Ross (48.3)."

The mile relay with Larry Beebe and McKinney running with Ross and Rowdon stepped off a 3:14.8 time to break the meet record set by Northeast last year. The time was the best of the season for the team.

The only other first place winner for the Tribe was Jack McDougall with a 6 - 8 leap in the high jump. It broke his mark of 6 - 4 set last year.
