Dear Mr. Drake:

The biggest news here is Ron Jourdan's 7'2" high jump here in Knoxville February 14. Jourdan cleared 6-6, 6-8, 6-10, and 7-0 all on his first attempt, and cleared 7-2 on his second try. He missed three times at 7-3 $\frac{1}{4}$. Audry Hardy ran a 1:10.6 600 in the same meet, which should be a new world record for a 10-lap, flat track (ours is Tartan-surfaced). Richmond Flowers ran a 7.2 in his first meet since the Cotton Bowl--this with only one week's practice. Robert Sprung hit 16-0 in the pole vault, and Larry Kelly, running a spirited last lap, overtook Florida's Eammon O'Keefe in the final 45-50 yards for a 1:52.7. Darwin Bond, from Kingsport (Tenn.) Dobyons-Bennett H.S. ran 6.4 and 51.9 in the high school 60 and 440.

Here are the Tennessee bests to date:

- 60: Gary Wagner and Wayne Whigham have both run 6.2.
- 500: Hardee McAlhaney ran 56.9 at Millrose Games. Roy Reeves had a n57.7 at Mason-Dixon Games.
- 600: Hardee McAlhaney's 1:08.1 and Audry Hardy's 1:10.6 vs. Florida and Ga. Tech.
- 880: Larry Kelly 1:52.7 and Audry Hardy's n1:54.3.
- 1000: James Craig 2:13.4.
- Mile: Dickie Kleier's n4:08.1 at Mason-Dixon and Dave Scire's 4:09.2.
- Two-Mile: Owen Self 9:06.1 vs. Florida & Ga. Tech.
- 50 HH: Bill High 6.2, Steve Keltner n6.3.
- 60 HH: Six of our hurdlers have qualified for the NCAA indoor meet. Must be the best group of hurdlers at any school in the nation. They are Richmond Flowers (Sr.) 7.2, Bill High (Fr.) 7.2, Steve Keltner (Sr.) 7.3 in prelims vs. Fla./Ga. Tech; Bobby Ball n7.3 (he's a soph); Jimmy Cutler (Fr.) 7.4 in a heat and Pete Mattina, a n7.4 in a heat (he's also a freshman).
- Mile Relay: 3:15.8 at Louisville (Gary Womble 49.7, Roy Reeves 49.3, Larry Kelly 48.5, and Audry Hardy 48.3).
- Two-Mile Relay: 7:38.2 at Louisville (James Craig 1:55.8, Audry Hardy 1:53.0, Larry Kelly 1:52.9, Butch Stewart 1:56.5)
- Triple Jump: Jeff Gabel 49-5 $\frac{1}{4}$, and Chris D'Orazio 48-1 $\frac{1}{2}$.
- High Jump: Karl Kremser 6-11, and Lonnie Hance 6-10 $\frac{1}{2}$. Your listing of Hance at 6-11 at the VMI Winter Relays in the latest Track Newsletter was incorrect. He did 6-6.
- Pole Vault: Robert Sprung 16'0"
- Shot Put: Chip Kell 56'5"
