# Railsback Vaults 17-5½; Bruins Win

Dick Railsback vaulted 17-5½, best outdoor mark in the world this year, and Steve Marcus set a school record of 64-1 in the shot as UCLA overwhelmed Washington, 105-35, Saturday in a Pacific-8 dual meet at Westwood.

Railsback's mark broke the UCLA school record of 17-5 set last year by Jon Vaughn. Vaughn is currently bothered by a heel injury.

Railsback took three tries at the world record height of 18-0 but went under the bar on each try.

"I can't be anything but pleased," said Railsback. "I'm just starting to get my technique down. Guys like Bob Seagren and Jon Vaughn already have their technique down."

Railsback, who has been bothered in the past by a congenital vertebrae problem, said, "I haven't been vaulting in practice for months. The vertebrae always feel more stable if I don't vault in practice."

Marcus, in the shot, broke his own school record of 63-¾ set last year.
