# Hot W&M Trackmen Rout VMI

LEXINGTON (Special to Daily Press) — William and Mary's depth-rich track team flexed its muscles here Friday afternoon in crushing host Virginia Military Institute, 120-34, in its 1969 outdoor debut. The Indians won all 18 events and scored sweeps in the 880 and three-mile races.

Double winners for the were Scott McLennan (long and triple jumps), Mike Fratkin (100 and 220) and freshman Dennis Cambal (shot put and discus).

Freshmen accounted for five first places with Guy Kirton capturing the 3,000-meter steeplechase, Charles Strode the pole vault and Bob Daniel the javelin in addition to Cambal's success in the weight events.

McLennan's leap of 23 feet, 2 inches edged teammate Tom Duffey by an inch in the long jump. McLennan also did 44-10½ in the triple jump. He is the reigning Southern Conference outdoor champion in both events.

Cambal set a William and Mary discus record with a toss of 151-5, bettering the 149-foot mark set last year by Robert Davis. Cambal's 46-3½ throw won the shot put competition as teammate freshman Roger Eitelman was unable to see action because of a pulled muscle.

Fratkin was clocked at 9.7 seconds in capturing the 100 and 21.8 in his 220 success.

Doug Griffith equalled his school standard of 14.3 in an impressive high hurdles triumph. Mark Decot was runner-up. Decot also finished second to Dave Watson (55.6) in the 400-yard intermediate hurdles.
