SUBJECT: BADGER TRACK TEAM WHIPS HOOSIERS 100-73

MADISON, WIS -- UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN'S OUTDOOR
TRACK TEAM COMPLETED AN UNBEATEN SEASON IN DUAL AND TRIANGULAR MEETS HERE
SATURDAY AFTERNOON BY TURNING ASIDE INDIANA'S STRONG CHALLENGE BY A SCORE
OF 100-73. THE MEET WAS CONDUCTED DURING INTERMITTENT SHOWERS IN 46-DEGREE
WEATHER WITH WIND GUSTS UP TO 35 MILES PER HOUR AFTIMES.

THE BADGERS WON TWELVE OF THE EIGHTEEN EVENTS ON THE DAY'S CARD INCLUDING EVERY FLAT RACE FROM THE QUARTERMILE THROUGH THE THREE MILE RUN PLUS THE 120 YARD HIGH HURDLE AND 440 YARD INTERMEDIATE HURDLE EVENTS AND THE MILE RELAY. WISCONSIN ALSO WON THE 3,000 METER STEEPLECHASE.

INDIANA DOMINATED BOTH DASH EVENTS WHERE LARRY HIGHBAUGH WON THE 100 IN A WIND-AIDED 9.4 SECONDS, AND MIKE GOODRICH THE 220 IN 21.9 SECONDS. BOTH RUNNERS HELPED TO GIVE THE HOOSIERS THE 440 YARD RELAY IN AN EASY 43.8 SECONDS ALONG WITH KEN LUNDGREN AND JIM RICKS AS THE BADGERS DROPPED THE BATON ON THE FIRST EXCHANGE BETWEEN MIKE BUTLER AND LARRY FLOYD.

THE TEAMS SPLIT THE SIX FIELD EVENTS WITH GLENN DICK WINNING THE LONG JUMP AT 23-9 AND MIKE BOND THE TRIPLE JUMP AT 48-9 FOR THE BADGERS AND JOE VIKTOR WON THE POLE VAULT AT 15 FEET AS INDIANA'S PAUL GAYDOS DID NOT COMPEVE. RICH FUNS OF THE HOOSIERS SET A TRACK RECORD IN WINNING THE DISCUS AT 176 FEET.

WISCONSIN CO-CAPTAIN RAY ARRINGTON WON BOTH THE MILE RUN AND HALF-MILE, NIPPING SOPHOMORE DON VANDREY IN 4:14.8 FOR THE MILE, AND HOLDING OFF JUNIOR GARY THORNTON IN THE HALF-MILE IN 1:56.4.

CO-CAPTAIN MIKE BUTLER OF THE BADGERS SET A NEW TRACK
MARK OF 13.7 SECONDS IN THE 120 YARD HIGH HURDLES AND SOPHOMORE MARK
WINZENRIED TOURED THE 660 IN 1:18.0 FOR ANOTHER NEW TRACK RECORD
