SUBJECT: BADGER TRACKMEN DEFEAT IOWA STATE 115-35

MADISON, Wis -- UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN'S POWERFUL INDOOR TRACK TEAM GOT OFF TO A FLYING START HERE SATURDAY WITH AN EASY 115-35 VICTORY OVER IOWA STATE.

THE BADGERS HAD THREE DOUBLE WINNERS IN SENIOR CO-CAPTAINS MIKE BUTLER, CHAMPAIGN, ILL., IN THE HIGH AND LOW HURDLES; AND RAY ARRINGTON IN THE 880 AND MILE; AND SOPHOMORE TERRY BROWN, ROCKFORD, ILLINOIS IN THE 60 AND 300 YARD DASHES.

BUTLER WON HIS SPECIALTIES IN 8.5 SECS., AND 7.9 SECS., RESPECTIVELY, WHILE ARRINGTON WON THE 880 IN MEET RECORD TIME OF 1:53.5, AND TIED FOR THE MILE WITH TEAMMATE DON VANDREY, A SOPHOMORE FROM VALPARAISO IND., IN 4:14, A MARK WHICH ALSO SET A MEET RECORD. BROWN WAS TIMED IN 6.4 SECONDS FOR THE 60 YARD DASH, AND EDGED PAST IOWA STATE'S JIM WALSTROM IN THE FINAL STRIDE TO WIN THE 300 YARD DASH IN 31.9 SECONDS.

ARRINGTON'S HALF-MILE TIME LOWERED THE MARK OF 1:55.2 FOR THE EVENT SET TWO YEARS AGO BY RICKEY POOLE OF THE BADGERS, WHILE HIS MILE TIME OF 4:14 WAS A SECOND BETTER THAN HIS TIME IN WINNING THE RACE LAST YEAR AGAINST IOWA STATE.

ONE OTHER BADGER RECORD BREAKER WAS MONROE SOPHOMORE MARK WINZENRIED WHO TOURED THE 1000 YARD RUN IN 2:10.0, TO LOWER THE MEET MARK OF 2:10.2 SET IN 1965 BY WISCONSIN'S BARNEY PETERSON.

THE CYCLONES WON THREE EVENTS AND IN TWO OF THEM SET MEET RECORDS. SOPHOMORE DENNIS MCGUIRE, FROM WATERLOO COLUMBUS HIGH SCHOOL WON THE TWO MILE RUN IN 9:14.0 AND IN SO DOING DEFEATED THE OLD RECORD HOLDER -- BOB GORDON OF THE BADGERS -- WHO WON TWO YEARS AGO IN 9:20.8.

ADD - 1 BADGERS DEFEAT IOWA STATE IN INDOOR TRACK

KEN BRAUMAN OF IOWA STATE SET MEET AND CAMP RANDALL MEMORIAL BUILDING RECORDS IN WINNING THE TRIPLE JUMP WITH A FINE EFFORT OF 47 FEET 6½ INCHES. IT MARKED THE FIRST TIME THE EVENT WAS EVER HELD IN AN INDOOR MEET HERE.

ANOTHER CYCLONE SOPHOMORE VERNIE HAWKINS OF DES MOINES WON THE LONG JUMP IN 23 FEET 3 INCHES TO NIP WISCONSIN'S GLENN DICK -- THE BIG TEN RUNNER-UP THE PAST TWO YEARS -- WHO LEAPED 22 FEET 11 3/4 INCHES.

TOM THIES OF WISCONSIN UPSET TEAMMATE JOE VIKTOR -- LAST YEAR'S BIG TEN CHAMPION -- TO WIN THE POLE VAULT AT 15 FEET EVEN, WHILE BRAD HANSON WON THE 60 YARD RUN IN NEAR RECORD TIME OF 1:11.8. HANSON IS FROM EAGLE GROVE, IOWA.

WISCONSIN'S ONE MILE RELAY TEAM OF LARRY FLOYD, MARK KARTMAN, HANSON AND WINZENRIED TURNED IN AN EXCEPTIONAL 3:17.4 FOR ANOTHER MEET RECORD.

A CROWD OF 1,248 FANS WATCHED THE MEET WHICH MARKED WISCONSIN'S SIXTH STRAIGHT DUAL MEET WIN OVER THE PAST TWO SEASONS AND EXTENDED THEIR STRING OF DUAL MEET WINS OVER IOWA STATE TO FOUR SINCE THEIR FIRST MEETING IN 1965.
