MADISON, WIS -- UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN ALL-AMERICAN SOPHOMORE HALF-MILER MARK WINZENRIED, MONROE, TURNED IN THE FASTEST HALF-MILE INDOORS EVER RUN BY A BIG TEN UNDERGRADUATE HERE THIS AFTERNOON AS THE BADGERS DOMINATED A TRIANGULAR MEET WITH PURDUE AND IOWA BY SCORING 114 POINTS TO 38 FOR PURDUE AND 30 FOR IOWA.

WINZENRIED RAN AN EVEN PAGED RACE IN TOURING THE 880 YARDS IN 1:49.9 IN DEFEATING TEAMMATE DON VANDREY AND PURDUE'S JIM JACKSON WHO FINISHED SECOND AND THIRD, RESPECTIVELY IN 1:52.7. HE RAN THE FIRST 220 IN 26.5 SECONDS, WAS CLOCKED IN 54 SECONDS FOR THE QUARTER-MILE; HAD A TIME OF 1:22.0 FOR 660 YARDS, AND RAN THE FINAL 220 YARDS IN 27.9 SECONDS.

WINZENRIED, WHO WAS NAMED TO THE AAU ALL-AMERICAN TRACK AND FIELD TEAM LAST WEEK, AND A FOURTH PLACE FINISHER IN THE 880 YARDS IN THE OLYMPIC TRIALS AT LAKE TAHOE LAST SEPTEMBER, RAN THE HALF-MILE IN 7:50.1 INDOORS HERE LAST YEAR IN A USTFF MEET FOR THE BEST PREVIOUS MARK EVER TURNED IN FOR THE EVENT INDOORS BY A CONFERENCE UNDERGRADUATE ATHLETE.

THE BADGERS WON TWELVE OF 16 EVENTS ON THE DAY'S PROGRAM
